<u>Activity</u> **1 Videos:** Watch the video "New Plant Life" Talk about flowers and plants to your adult. Do you know the names for some of the plants? Can you find some new plant life in your garden? Take a photo of what you find. What are their names?

Activity 2 Watch and Sing along to: Mary Mary Watch and Sing Along to: Oats and Beans and Barley Grow

<u>Activity 3</u> Can you make a flower or a picture of a flower using cupcake cases/circles of coloured paper?

Activity 4 If you have the resources available: Can you plant some seeds? What about planting some sunflower seeds, when they have grown you could measure how tall they are? Plant some seeds to give you some "healthy food" like salad or courgettes. If you can't use the garden, how about a "Cress head", you can grow this on your windowsill, using eggshells.
