Number of the Week: 8 Watch: Numberblocks: 8

Can you make 8 with your fingers? Can you find 8 different objects in your house? You could find 8 pencils, 8 toys, 8 books etc. Can you write the number 8?



Make 8: Using the items you have found around your house, 8 pencils, 8 toys etc. How many different ways can you make 8? Take some photos and send them to us on Evidence Me.

Shape of the Week: circle. Play "I spy a Shape". Have a shape hunt to find circles around your house. Get your adult to take a photo of all the ones you find.

Irresistible Learning Topic: Over the Rainbow: Weather: Day/Night/Stormy Weather.

Colour- black

<u>Activity 1</u> Day and Night: Talk about things that are associated with the day and night. Fold a piece of paper in half, draw or sort some "day" and "night" pictures.

<u>Activity 2</u> Rainy Day clothes: Find all the things in your house that you need for a stormy/rainy day. Dress up in your outfit. If it's raining and you can, go outside in your rainy day clothes. Take some photos.

<u>Activity 3</u> Circle Art: paint or draw some circles. Can you make patterns inside the circles? You could practise cutting out some circles. How good is your cutting?



<u>Activity 4</u> Log onto <u>Espresso</u>-Understanding of the World-Weather-Videos- What's the weather like? Watch the video and talk about what you've seen. Go back to the activities section and play "Weather Snap"
