







Remote-learning



Year Group: Year 1	WEEK BEGINNING: 05.07.21
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This is an overview of the main areas of learning in Year 1 for this week which will link to the learning going on in school. Please use these as the main activities for remote-learning if your child is unable to attend school during this week.

<p>Maths This week we will be learning all about Length and Height. Complete one Oak Academy lesson per day in the following order:</p>   <p>Oak Academy: Lesson 1: Comparing Lengths and Heights of Objects Lesson 2: Measuring using Non-Standard Units Lesson 3: Measuring Length using Non-Standard Units (Part 2) Lesson 4: Beginning to Understand Standard Units of Length Lesson 5: Solving Length and Height Problems Involving Doubling and Halving</p> <p>Challenge: Find objects around your house and see if you can measure them using both standard (with a ruler or tape measure) and non-standard (hands, feet, spoons, paper clips etc) ways of measuring. Why not have a go at estimating the length or height before seeing how close you can get to being correct each time.</p> <p>Mental fluency: This week we would like you to practise your doubles either on a piece of paper or using this link. See how quick your recall of your doubles is.</p> <p>Remember your teachers love to see your work so don't forget to upload your work to your folder on Purplemash or send them to your teachers via 2Email. There is also a display board called Length and Height to showcase all the different objects you found to measure around your house and how you did it.</p>	<p>English – Oak Academy – Explanation How Beans Grow Complete one lesson per day (Lessons 1-5). *Additional Writing Task* -</p> <p>Task 1: This week we are carrying on with the story of Bright Stanley, watch the story to remind you what the book is all about. Now it's your turn to write the beginning of the story, remember to use full stops, capital letters and finger spaces in your writing.</p> <p>Task 2: Carry on your writing of Bright Stanley today, this time writing the middle.</p> <p>Task 3: Finally, finish off your story of Bright Stanley by writing the ending.</p> <p>Task 4: check back your work! Go back and check that you have used capital letters, finger spaces and full stops throughout your work.</p> <p>Phonics: Recap your phase 3 sounds by watching this video. This week we are looking at 'g' in gem and 'c' in ice. Can you think of any other words that have these sounds in? Practise some of your tricky words by singing this song. This week we are recapping the tricky words by and our. Can you put our tricky words into sentences?</p> <p>Reading: Pick a story book from home or one from Bug Club. Why did you pick this book? What do you think this book is going to be about? Halfway through the book stop reading and make a prediction about how you think the story will end, you could even draw a picture of your prediction just like we do at school. Then carry on reading and see if your prediction was right.</p>
