
Year Group: Year 3 WEEK BEGINNING: 21.06.21

Maths

This week we will be revisiting fractions using Oak Academy. Start <u>lesson 11</u> and complete a new lesson every day.

Challenge: Think carefully about these challenge questions.







Fluency:

Log onto <u>TT Rock Stars</u> to improve your speed and recall of multiplication and division facts. Count on and back in steps of 50, make your own number line and see how quickly you can count forwards and backwards. Then have a go at counting in steps of 25, make a numberline and see which numbers are on the same when you count in steps of 25 and 50, can you explain why?

English

Oak Academy: This week we are starting a unit on narrative writing about <u>The Fate of Fausto</u>, start on lesson six and complete a new lesson every day.

Writing challenge: This week we are going to be writing about adventure stories, listen to the story <u>Escape from Pompeii</u>, stop the video at 5.50. Then write what you think will happen next in the story. You could email your writing to us using 2Email.

Reading: Have some fun logging on to Bug Club and see what books you have been given to read. Remember you can also

Science- Seed investigation


