1 20/4/20	Talking about holidays  Road travel- what transport travels on the road?	1 Circle Red Bus	Wheels on the bus  Any information books about transport	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>PD:</b> Practising pencil control by drawing roads with pencils, felts or chalks on the ground for cars, lorries etc to go on.</li> <li>• <b>Fine Motor Skills:</b> play dough [make cars, lorries out of playdough], cutting around simple shapes like circles for wheels, jigsaws.</li> <li>• <b>CL:</b> Talking about experiences of going out for the day and/or holidays. Ask questions such as: Where did you go? What did you see? Where is your favourite place to go? (See website links to left)</li> </ul>
2 27/4/20	Rail travel	2 Square Green Train	'The Train Ride' by June Crebbin [This is on YouTube]  Thomas the Tank Engine stories	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Phonics:</b> Find a bag and put objects in, that begin with the same initial sound. Get your child to pull out an object one at a time and empathise the initial sound. E.g. ssssssss for snake, ssssssss for sock etc so children get used to hearing initial sounds in words. Can they think of other words that begin with that sound?</li> <li>• <b>Writing:</b> Practice writing their name in lower case letters.</li> <li>• <b>UW:</b> Listen and talk about the Listen and Play Programmes (see left)</li> <li>• <b>EAD:</b> Paint/Draw a picture of your favourite vehicle. Make a train: Get several pieces of paper, draw an engine on one and carriages on the others. How long can you make your train?</li> <li>• <b>MD:</b> Twinkl: Trains and Carriages 1-5 Twinkl: Transport I Spy and Count 1-10. Counting cars/trains/toys.</li> <li>• <b>Small World/Construction:</b> Make a vehicle/car/train from your Lego or Duplo or cardboard boxes.</li> <li>• <b>Water/Sand (if available):</b> General Play. Fill and empty bottles, jugs bowls: Just play in the sand, What can you make?</li> </ul>
