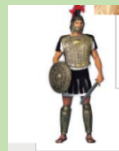

**Irresistible Learning:**

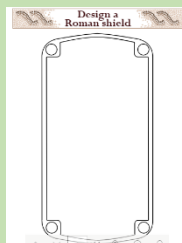

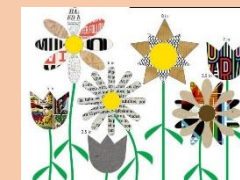
Think about ways that you could make a difference:
