Number, shape & measures: Number of the Week: 8
[Numberblocks Number 8](#) Can you write the number 8? Can you find 8 spoons, 8 toys, 8 cups etc? Do you know any creatures that have 8 legs?




Shape of the Week: rectangle- How many sides does it have? How is it different to a square?
Size: Find some of your family member's shoes and see if you put them in order of size. Who had the biggest shoes? Who had the smallest? **Find out what shoe size you are.**




Irresistible Learning Topic: Knock, Knock, Who's There: The Elves and the shoemaker
Colour- purple

Activity 1: Design your own pair of shoes. What colours will you use? What will you draw on them? What materials could you use to decorate it? Send a picture of your shoes to Evidence Me.

Word of the Week: measure
Reading We are sharing the story of **The Elves and the Shoemaker** this week. Listen to the story [The Elves and the Shoemaker](#) who was making the shoes? How did the shoemaker find out it was them? Say how you think the shoemaker is feeling at different times during the story.
Phonics: This week we are learning the sound 'h'. Listen to this song [Jolly phonic song h](#) see if you can do the action and say the sound. Can you think of anything that begins with 'h'? Writing/Mark Making: Can you draw round some shoes you have at home and some of your family's shoes? Who has the biggest shoes?
