Make your own bunting for your teddy bears picnic.

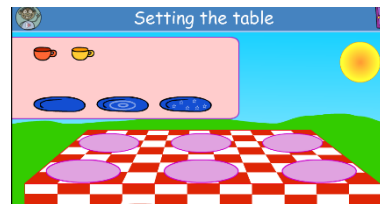


Cut out different size triangles and decorate them with different patterns. Think carefully about how many sides a triangle needs.
