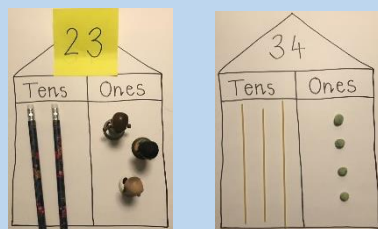
Challenge:

Task 1: Have a go at the 2Dos set for you on PurpleMash for ordering and comparing numbers up to 100!

Task 2: Time to get your thinking caps on! Can you find objects in your house or use sticks and stones from outside to show Mr Tens and Mrs Ones? Choose three numbers between 1 and 50 to represent with your objects. Have a look at our examples above to give you an idea of the objects you could use.

Mental fluency:

Can you start at 50 and count back to 0? Time yourself on your first go and see if you can improve your time!



Irresistible Learning – Science

This week in topic we are going to be learning about everyday materials and their properties.

Do you know any materials already? Have a look around your room and see if you can guess what materials objects are made from.

Task 1- We would like you to go on a material hunt! Look around your house and see how many different everyday materials you can find. Can you sort these objects into the correct groups e.g., wood, plastic, metal, paper etc.

Task 2- Today we would like you to use your sense of touch for this activity. Have a look at the objects you have sorted, this time we would like you to have a go at explaining the properties of the materials e.g., soft, rough, hard, smooth etc.

Task 1: Read your favourite book (someone can read it to you). Why is this your favourite book? Write a sentence to explain why it is your favourite.

Task 2: Draw a story map for your favourite book to show your teacher what happens in the story. Challenge: can you write a key word/sentence under each picture?

Task 3: Create a new ending for your favourite book. If you could choose any ending for the book, what would you choose, try and be as imaginative as possible.

Task 4: Complete a book review on your favourite book. There is a book review template set as a 2Do on PurpleMash if you would like to use it.

Activity- To celebrate World Book Day, you might want to create a hat to represent your favourite character, story or book.

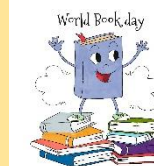


Wellbeing – World Book Day
