

Lesson 5 - Using comparative symbols to compare numbers


**Challenge:** Dora has 20 sweets and Amir has 15 sweets. Represent the total number of sweets as a drawing, a part-whole model and as a number sentence.

# Irresistible Learning (Topic) Storms and Shipwrecks








### **English**
